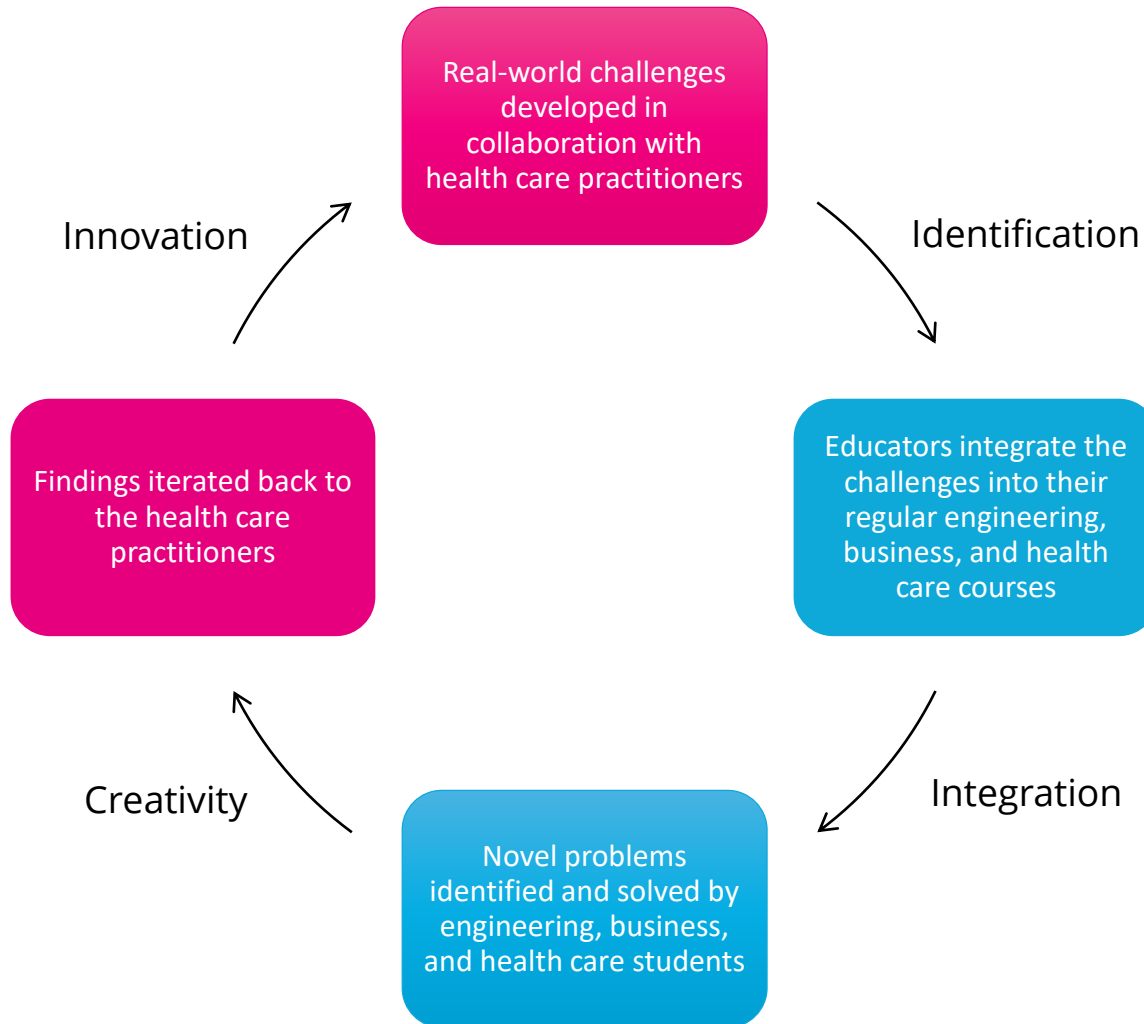

The Basic Idea



The Health Challenges



- **Contains a set of (unidentified) problems within a given field of practice-orientated knowledge**
 - Formulated by or in collaboration with practitioners from the health care system
 - Must lead to new problems identified by the students
 - Can be formulated as a question or as an statement
 - Can be supported by data and/or a case description



Entry Points



- **Challenge centered initiation**
 - The challenge is yet to be identified or elaborated
- **Objective centered initiation**
 - The challenge is known and elaborated
- **Research centered initiation**
 - The challenge is known, elaborated, and include research data

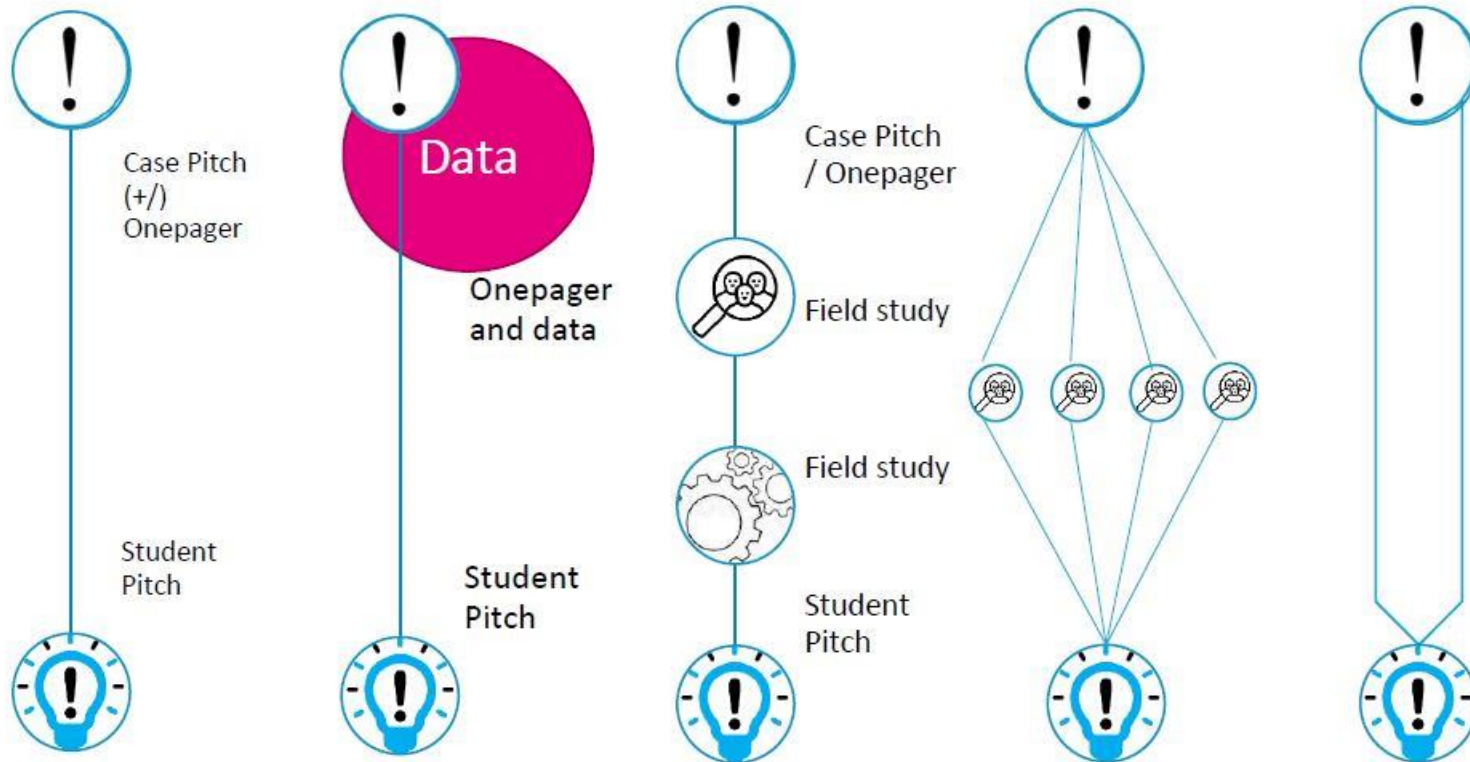
- **Health practitioners**

- The challenge will be solved over a short period of time

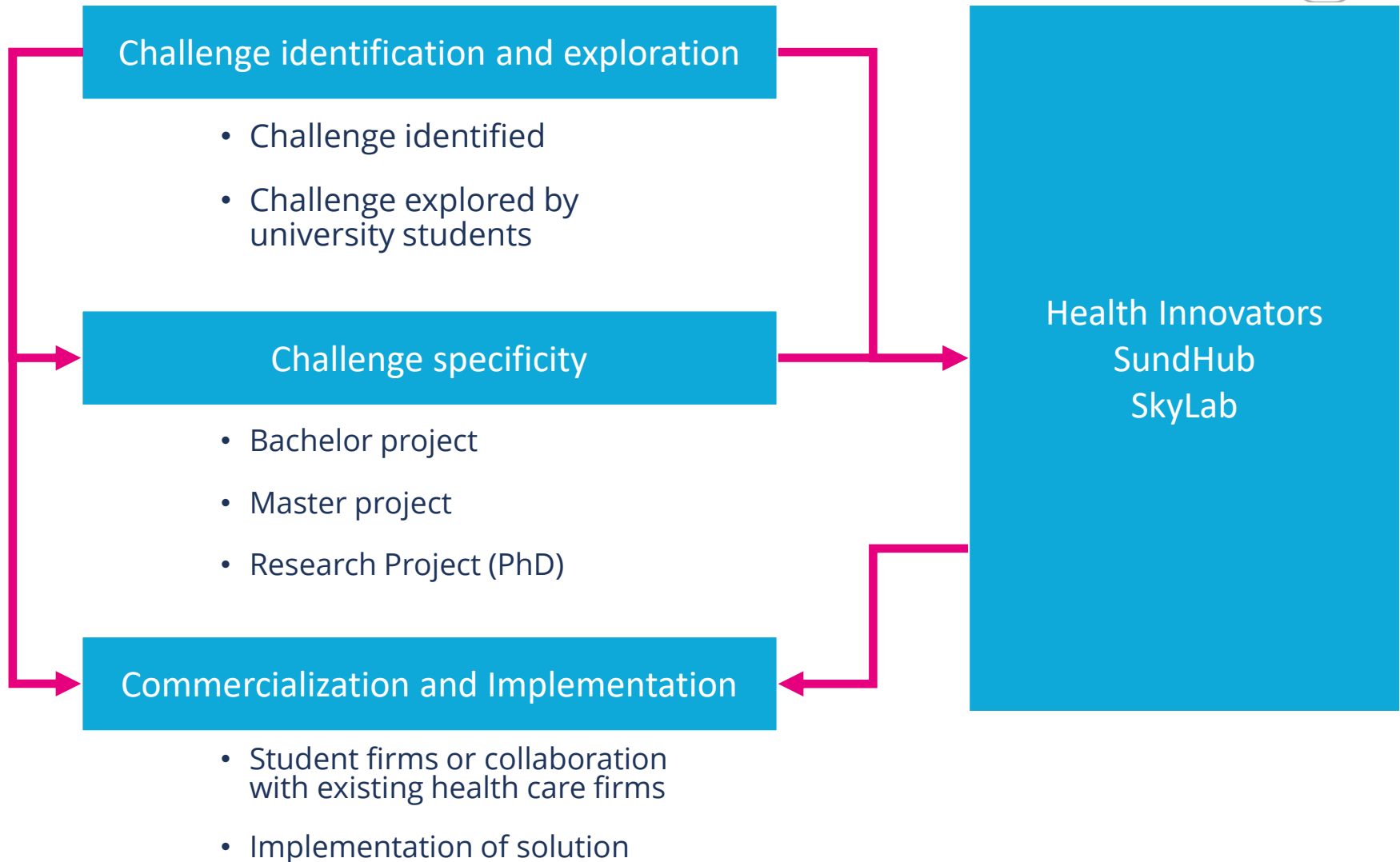
- **Educators**
